NOMINATION & ELECTION NOTICE

This is your Official Notice that the present term of office for all incumbent officers of Teamsters Local # 42 will terminate December 31, 2017. In accordance with the Local Union By-Laws, the Nominations will be held on **Sunday, September 10, 2017** at **10:30 A.M.**, at **Teamsters Local 42 Union Hall, 96 Ford Street, Lynn, Massachusetts.**

Nominations and seconds will be taken orally from the floor by members in good standing other than the nominee. For a member to be eligible to nominate or second a nomination, dues must be paid through the month prior to the month nominations are held. Candidates must accept nominations at the time made, either in person, or if absent, in writing. The 50% attendance requirement shall not be enforced as a condition of eligibility to run for office in this election.

Nominations will be taken for the following offices for a three (3) year term commencing on January 1, 2018 and concluding on December 31, 2020.

The election of Officers shall be by Secret Ballot. To be eligible to vote, you must be a member of Local # 42 in good standing and you must have your dues paid for the month previous to the Election. Dues may be paid at Local #42 Union Office during the election hours. This Election will be a walk-in vote by paper ballot.

“Members on check-off are eligible to vote if they had sufficient money owed them by their employer from which dues for the month previous to the election meeting could have been deducted”. “Voting by writing in the name of a person who was not duly nominated shall not be permitted. Any Ballot shall be declared Void if it contains any mark other than the Voting Mark”. “Absentee Voting by mail shall be permitted only upon application of members who are ill or absent from the city or town where they are normally employed at the time of voting because of vacations or on employment tour of duty”. Applications for Absentee Ballots shall be made to the Secretary Treasurer of the Local Union not less than five (5) days prior to the date set for Election and shall contain the grounds therefore”. (I. B. T. Constitution Article XXII Section 4)
